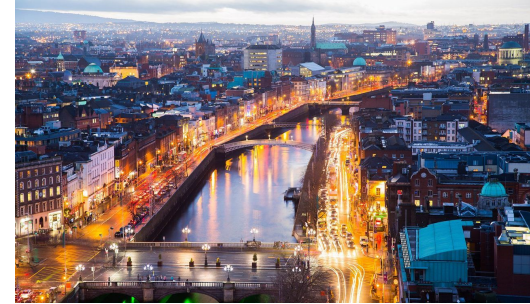
AN UNFORGETTABLE EXPERIENCE IN DUBLIN
